Functional English

Students will be working on reading, writing and speaking & listening skills that they will need in order to be independent after SDS. Skills such as: writing their address, interview skills and everyday reading skills.

Functional Maths

Working towards a BTEC Entry Level award in Mathematical skills, including an awareness of shape, measure and number; applying this to all aspects of daily life.

Work Related Learning

Students will be carrying out projects and site based tasks, developing practical and teamwork skills. This will mainly be focused on the continual development of the new Sixth form sensory garden.

BTEC Health & Fitness

Students are engaging in well being sessions that include both meditation and yoga.

Daily Living Skills

Students will be developing their skills in areas such as travel training and shopping for essential items. They will learn how to behave appropriately in a public place, and begin to carry out transactions with money.

SALT (Speech and Language Therapist Sessions)

Students will spend the term participating in social group activities designed to encourage and develop conversational skills, such as turn taking and listening, in a small group environment.

ICT – Pupils will learn how to stay safe online, recognise the difference between a stranger and someone they know. Pupils will understand what personal information is and how to make strong passwords.

Stony Dean School 16M Group

Humanities / Foreign Cultures (16K)— Pupils will focus on the geography and culture of India. They will learn about the very different physical features of India such as the Himalayan mountains and Thar desert. Then they will learn about India's fascinating buildings and the stories about why they are important. We will take a look at the Hindu religion and its beliefs and culture.

Music BTEC Entry 1 Unit 36 - exploring music.

Students will be introduced to the fundamentals of music. Lessons will include: Listening to music and stating the feelings it evokes; identifying a musical instrument and its sound; playing a musical instrument with others and expressing feelings from playing in a group. Different genres of music will be explored and the feelings regarding them discussed.

Learning for Life

The students will learn to recognise the difference between right and wrong and their readiness to apply this understanding in their own lives.

Resistant Materials – Pupils are engaging in a Tray project using reclaimed and refurbished timber from wooden pallets. This project is being completed in conjunction with their BTEC qualification in Pre-Vocational Study.

Art 16M— Students will explore and discuss the mediums of Pop Art and Collage; looking at different artists' work and comparing opinions. Pop Art work will be created both physically and through the use of computers, and students will use a wide range of materials and techniques to create collages.

Food Tech – Pupils will be making quick, simple and easy snacks/meals. This will involve using kitchen appliances such as a kettle, microwave and an oven.
