<u>English</u>

The topic this term is Space and pupils will listen and read a range of different non-fiction texts based on space. Students will create their own fiction stories based on space adventure and will learn about story structure by identifying beginnings, middles, and endings using story maps and colourful semantics. Identified students will also be taking part in The Little Wandle phonics programme to develop their reading and spelling abilities.

Food Tech

Pupil will learn in food technology; how to work safely and hygienically, inclusive of both personal hygiene and kitchen hygiene which encourages a healthy working environment for all students. Covering the Eat Well Guide, students will be aware of the different food groups and what eating a balanced diet means.

Science

This term in science we will be focussing on physics and space. This includes learning about push and pull forces, gravity and understanding our solar system. Students will take part in experiments, use science equipment safely and write up the reports afterwards.

Daily Living Skills

In Daily Living Skills this term we are focusing on keeping our environment clean and safe. This includes morning and night time routines, and general housekeeping to promote independence and taking responsibility.

<u>ICT</u>

Pupils will learn about online safety and identifying potential dangers on the internet. Students will be able to define cyberbullying and explain how to report inappropriate online behaviour. They will also identify the differences between personal and private information.

Learning for Life

Students are learning about physical changes in the body. Topics covered will include: personal hygiene,

Foundation Stage NG1&2

<u>Art</u>

The focus this term is around space. Students are developing their fine motor skills through creating 3D rockets out of recycled materials and creating drawings of the planets.

<u>Music</u>

The focus of music this term is space and we will be learning about this topic through listening to 'Mars' from 'The Planets' by Gustav Holst. Students will explore the use of rhythm in the piece of music using percussion instruments and create a movement piece focussing on dynamics.

<u>Maths</u>

NG1 – Number and Place Value

Students are learning about number and place value through the White Rose Maths scheme of work. This term students will represent and solve simple addition and subtraction problems using a range of strategies. These strategies include counting on using a number line, using a part/ whole model and a variety of tactile resources such as counters and Numicon.

NG2 - Money

This term students are focussing on functional maths and will be using money out in the community when visiting shops and cafes. Students are also learning to recognise coins and notes, calculate change and the importance of keeping our money safe.

The World Around Us

For the spring term, the world around us will focus on the topic of Space. This topic looks at aspects of human knowledge of space. Pupils will discuss and learn the names of the planets in the solar system and constellations of stars. They will go on to look at how humans developed rockets and stories of aliens.

Leisure and Recreation

This term in Leisure and Recreation, we will be developing our conversation and turn taking skills during our trips to Rogue Bowling in Aylesbury. Students will use their maths skills out in the community through scoring and also using money to buy items at the café.
