

**English**

In English, pupils will be focusing on the theme of Rainforests for the first half term when we will read the book – ‘What the Macaw Saw’ by Charlotte Guillian. The second half term theme is the Commonwealth Games where we will read the book – ‘There was a wee lassie who swallowed a midgie’ by Rebecca Colby.

**SALT**

Students take part in weekly SALT sessions that focus on developing and strengthening key social communication skills. These sessions use a range of structured activities to support skills such as maintaining attention, active listening, taking turns, sharing space with others, and responding appropriately during interactions with peers. The sessions also explore emotions and emotional regulation, helping students recognise their feelings and use strategies to manage them effectively in social and learning situations.

**Science**

This term in science our focus is Biology and the body. Through practical experiments we will be looking at the importance of exercise, Heart rate, Injury prevention and recovery. How the body works in sport.

**Food Tech**

Pupils will learn the basics of food hygiene and learn how to prepare healthy dinners. They will also learn to understand ingredients and food culture of different countries.

**Daily Living Skills**

In Daily Living Skills in the summer term we will be focussing on preparing simple meals and snacks. From buying the ingredients and the supermarket, practicing our money skills to preparing the snack. Students will be learning how to do practical cleaning skills and how to take care of the garden and growing vegetables.

**ICT**

Pupils will continue to develop their ICT skills. They will learn how to make simple presentations, using shapes and animations. Aswell as continuing to learn about online safety and identifying potential dangers on the internet.

**Learning for Life**

In L4L students are learning about public and private places, stranger danger, puberty and personal hygiene keeping our bodies clean.

Our students will be able to have the opportunity to continue to develop their independence and social skills through fun activities at Chiltern open air museum, many trips, including a fishing trip, and other sporting activities.

**EHCP**

Students continue to work on their individual EHCP outcomes and understanding their own EHCPs. We are very lucky to welcome a volunteer from Chiltern Open Air Museum, who will be delivering interactive sensory stories to the students as part of their Sensory and Physical provision.
